We look forward to worshipping with you here at the Place of Grace! As we transition back to **Full In-Person Worship**, we want to provide you with the following updated Grace Temple Ministries protocol and CDC Covid-19 safety protocol.

Our Commitment:

- ✚ Grace Temple Ministries is committed to going beyond the basics of the CDC guidelines by routinely sanitizing and bio-protecting our facility.
- ✚ We will continue to offer masks for those who are not vaccinated or who prefer to continue self protection.
- ✚ We offer sanitizing stations at all entrances/exits and throughout our building facility.
- ✚ We will continue to keep seating distance in order to maximize your safety.

Update as per the CDC Guidelines:

- ✚ Fully vaccinated people no longer need to wear a mask or physically distance in **any setting**, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance.
- ✚ For the purposes of this guidance, people are considered fully vaccinated for Covid-19 two weeks after they have received their 2nd dose in a 2 dose series (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna) or two weeks after they have received a single dose vaccine (Johnson & Johnson/Janssen); there is currently no post vaccination time limit on fully vaccinated status.
- ✚ An unvaccinated person refers to individuals of all ages, including children that have not completed a vaccination series.
